

## Town of Culver 2010 Sidewalk & Curb Program

### Application Process:

1. Return completed application to Clerk-Treasurer's Office with measurements.
2. A Town representative will come and verify the measurements. Then you will be sent a letter stating the acceptance or rejection of your application, and the amount to be reimbursed if accepted. Applications are reviewed on a first-come, first-serve basis based on funds available, and subject to council approval.
3. Obtain and pay permit fee.
4. Hire contractor and complete sidewalk/curb installation or replacement.
5. Turn in a copy of the contractor's bill to the Clerk-Treasurer's Office. Once measurements and inspection have been completed, you will be sent a reimbursement check after the next regular council meeting (held the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month.)

### Property Owner Responsibilities:

- Owners will make their own arrangements with contractors and bear full responsibility for the work. A Town inspection before pouring concrete and after pouring concrete is required.
- Owners will be responsible for safety marking and notifying "Dig Safe" at 811 before and during construction.
- Owners will be responsible for the removal of rubble from an old sidewalk.
- Owners will be responsible for continued maintenance of the sidewalk, including snow removal in the winter.
- Projects must be completed by October 1, 2010 or within 90 days of application. Please call the Clerk-Treasurer's office with exceptions. (574-842-3140)

### Specifications and Reimbursement Rates:

- Driveway aprons from the sidewalk to the street are eligible for reimbursement. Steps and sidewalks from the house to the curb will **not** be covered.
- Sidewalks will be reimbursed at \$2.75 per square foot.
- Curb installations will be reimbursed at \$14.00 per lineal foot.
- Per parcel sidewalks and curbs are only eligible for participation in this program **ONCE**.
- Sidewalks and curbing must be installed as indicated on the attached specifications.
- Failure to install the sidewalk and/or curbing as specified (including ADA specifications) herein will result in no reimbursement and will require replacement.
